"I recommend fighting terrorist and extremist Islam, but I would not declare a boycott of, ostracism against or war on Muslims in general," Energy Minister Yuval Steinitz, a senior Likud lawmaker and Netanyahu confidant, told Israel's Army Radio.

"If you're a Muslim in this community, as the leader of Facebook I want you to know that you are always welcome here and that we will fight to protect your rights and create a peaceful and safe environment for you," wrote Zuckerberg in a Facebook post.

The tone and intonation might be different between the Republican Donald Trump, the Democrat Barack Obama, the Jewish state Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu and Facebook founder Mark Zuckerberg. However all of their actions speak louder than words.

Reality shows that under the Barack Obama administration how many Muslims have been killed and become refugees in Syria because of US airstrikes.
