

## Obituary of a Dawah Carrier

### **Hizb ut Tahrir / Wilayah of Turkey Mourns Brother Fikret Tash, One of their Loyal Workers**

Brother Fikret Tash was one of the distinguished Shabab of Bursa. He carried the call with Hizb ut Tahrir in Bursa for thirteen years, and the people around him knew him for his honesty and humility, realizing that the Khilafah (Caliphate) would be through the resumption of the Islamic way of life and implementation of the rules of Allah's law on earth; as a matter of death and life, and a fateful issue for all Muslims, so he worked for it, fought for the sake of establishing it, and vowed his life like all his fellow Shababs to call for the sake of the Islamic call, until the promise of Allah came and his soul returned to His Lord, the Most Gracious, Glory be to Him.
